<b>Description</b> Request for Feature, wiki link macro to custom query. Format proposal is as follows. <pre>{{query_link("link text", 3)}}</pre> This is equivalent to  <code>http://redmine.example.com/projects/alfa?query_id=3</code>  where <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="http://redmine.example.com">http://redmine.example.com</a> is host dns name for redmine server</li><li>• alfa is a project identifier that the wiki page is belong to.</li></ul> But wiki macro does not contains project identifier, so this macro is valid if the wiki pages copied to another projects. A project id wiki page is belong to is implicitly applicated to the link.  I tried to create a simple and initial step <sup>1</sup> of wiki macro linking to custom query in my blog (in Japanese). <a href="http://d.hatena.ne.jp/torutk/20161007">http://d.hatena.ne.jp/torutk/20161007</a>  <sup>1</sup> no error checking, no flexible parameters, and no consistent parameter format to wiki lists' wiki links.
